Ingredients


- 6 cups milk
- 2 cups semisweet chocolate chips
- 1 ½ cups heavy whipping cream
- 1 (14 ounce) can sweetened condensed milk
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract

Directions

- 1. Combine milk, chocolate chips, cream, condensed milk, and vanilla in a slow cooker.
- 2. Cover and cook on Low, stirring occasionally, until chocolate chips are melted and mixture is smooth, about 2 hours.
