Laura Bush's Cowboy Cookies

Recipe tested by Southern Living Test Kitchen

Yield: 24 large cookies

Ingredients

- 3 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 Tbsp. baking powder

- 1 Tbsp. baking soda
- 1 Tbsp. ground cinnamon
- 1 tsp. kosher salt
- 1 1/2 cups butter, room temperature
- 1 1/2 cups granulated sugar
- 1 1/2 cups light-brown sugar, packed
- 3 large eggs
- 1 Tbsp. vanilla extract
- 3 cups semisweet chocolate chips
- 3 cups old-fashioned rolled oats
- 2 cups sweetened flake coconut
- 2 cups chopped pecans

Directions

1. Combine dry ingredients:

Heat oven to 350°F. Mix flour, baking powder, baking soda, cinnamon and salt in bowl.

2. Cream butter and sugar:

In 8-quart bowl, beat butter on medium speed until smooth and creamy, 1 minute. Gradually beat in

sugars to combine, 2 minutes. Add eggs, one at a time, beating after each.

Beat in vanilla. Stir in flour mixture until just combined. Add chocolate chips, oats, coconut and pecans.

3. Scoop cookie dough:

For each cookie, drop 1/4 cup dough onto ungreased baking sheets, spacing 3 inches apart.

4. Bake cookies:


Bake in 350°F oven 17 to 20 minutes, until edges are lightly browned; rotate sheets halfway through.

Let cookies cool 10 minutes on baking sheet, then remove cookies to rack to cool.

Tip:

Recipe update June 2022: This recipe yields 24 large cookies—the recipe calls for 1/4 cup of dough per cookie. Some might even call these cowboy cookies *giant*. The measurements for baking powder and baking soda (1 tablespoon of each) are correct in ratio to the amount of flour.
