I wanted to remind everyone that in addition to our own in-house ride challenge (most miles), HOG has a few of their own challenges they run each year. ***Website:** members.harley-davidson.com/HOG link also on stormridersok.com

1. **Ride 365** – For miles rode, you receive "H-D Reward Points". These are the same points you acquire when making Harley Purchases.

1,000 MILES = 1,000 POINTS | 2,500 MILES = 1,500 POINTS

5,000 MILES = 2,500 POINTS | 7,500 MILES = 2,500 POINTS

10,000 MILES = 2,500 POINTS | 15,000 MILES = 5,000 POINTS

2. **Dealership Photo Challenge** – Photo of you, your bike, and the current HOG Membership Guide in front of a Dealership. 10 or more receive a Commemorative Pin & Patch. (The most visited receive a \$2,000 H-D Gift Card)

3. **15 Rides for '25** – Each Destination visited earns you a Commemorative Challenge Coin. *see *website for details*

4. **50 Rides, One Nation** – Fifty great states, 50 life-changing rides. Bacon Dip

Total Time Prep: 15 min. Cook: 2 hours

This crowd-pleasing cheesy bacon dip won't last long on your appetizer table. Best served hot with tortilla chips or toasted French bread, this dip is versatile and filling.

Ingredients

- 2 packages (8 ounces each) cream cheese, cubed
- 4 cups shredded cheddar cheese

- 1 cup half-and-half cream
- 2 teaspoons Worcestershire sauce
- 1 teaspoon dried minced onion
- 1 teaspoon prepared mustard
- 16 bacon strips, cooked and crumbled
- Tortilla chips or toasted French bread slices

Directions

1. In a 1-1/2-qt. slow cooker, combine the first 6 ingredients. Cover and cook on low for 2-3 hours or until cheeses are melted, stirring occasionally.
2. Just before serving, stir in bacon. If desired, top with crumbled bacon. Serve warm with tortilla chips or toasted bread.
